

**REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS OF QUALIFICATIONS FOR PROVIDING
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING CONSULTANT SERVICES
TO THE CITY OF FORT WORTH, TEXAS**

Pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 2254, Subchapter A, the City of Fort Worth is requesting statements of qualifications from interested qualified engineering consulting firms to perform engineering design and professional services necessary for the following arterial and collector streets using Gas Well Revenues and other funding sources:

	PROJECT	LIMITS	DESCRIPTION
1.	Hulen Street	Carriage Crossing to Cleburne Rd	2 lanes of Major Arterial with bike lanes and sidewalks
2.	Thompson Road	Old Denton Road to Flowertree Dr	Minor Collector including bike lanes and sidewalk

- **M/WBE Compliance Efforts:** In accordance with the City of Fort Worth Ordinance 15550, the City of Fort Worth has goals for the participation of minority business enterprises and women business enterprises in City contracts. You may obtain a copy of the M/WBE Ordinance from the Office of the City Secretary or the M/WBE Office. All firms submitting proposals will be required to submit information concerning the M/WBEs that will participate in the contract to meet the City's goal of 20 percent for Hulen Street and 21 percent for Thompson Road . The information will include: (1) the name, address, and phone number of each M/WBE; (2) a detailed description of the work to be performed by each named M/WBE and (3) the overall M/WBE percentage you will achieve.

All M/WBE businesses must be certified or in the process of being certified by the North Central Texas Regional Certification Agency (NCTRCA) or the Texas Department of Transportation (TXDOT), highway division. The firm(s) must be located in the marketplace which includes the nine counties of: Tarrant, Parker, Johnson, Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Kaufman and Rockwall or doing business in the marketplace during negotiations related to this proposal. Six (6) copies of the statement of qualification on 8-1/2" x 11" paper (6 pages maximum excluding the cover sheet and appendices) in 12 point font size and single sided will be accepted by hand delivery, or by mail, until **4:00 p.m., Thursday, July 23, 2009**, at the Transportation and Public Works Office, 1000 Throckmorton Street, 2nd Floor, Fort Worth, TX 76102. Responses shall be placed in a sealed envelope addressed to Mr. Patrick Buckley, P.E. and clearly marked "Statement of Qualifications for Arterial and Collector Streets.
