Subject: Addendum No. 1 for Terrell Heights Street Light Project

---

The following changes to the RFP should be noted by all respective parties:

1. Information presented in the Proposals will be used to evaluate the professional qualifications and to determine which consultant will be selected to provide professional services to the City.
2. Responses shall be completed in accordance with the requirements of this RFP. Statements made by a Proposer shall be without ambiguity, and with adequate elaboration, where necessary, for clear understanding.
3. Six (6) copies of the proposal, which shall be limited to a maximum of six (6) 8-1/2" X 11" pages (one side only not including cover letter or resumes) using a font size no smaller than 11 point and one inch margins should be submitted.
4. There are no federal HUD requirements with infrastructure projects, i.e. street lights. As long as the light installation plan meets the City of Fort Worth code/regulations, then the project will be acceptable. In this case, Terrell Heights is a "neighborhood" street light project that must comply with City of Fort Worth local jurisdiction requirements for pedestrian and roadway lighting. The City of Fort Worth does not have a dark skies ordinance.
